

Myths about Remote Online Notarization

Myth	Truth
Remote Online Notarizations and online closings are not legal.	Remote Online Notarizations are legal throughout the United States.
	Virginia was the first state to authorize its notaries to notarize documents remotely via live audio-video technology in 2011, with the passage of House Bill 2318/Senate Bill 827. As of May 2019, more than 20 states have pass similar laws.
	While most states recognize and accept of out-of-state notarizations, always be sure to check with your title underwriting partners to understand their specific guidelines around insuring remote online notarizations.
Online closings are not secure.	Notarize takes privacy very seriously and has built bank-grade, highly secure software systems.
	For example, all user communications are encrypted and protected using industry-specific encryption protocols such as AES-256. All application accesses are also tracked using an audit trail.
	Notarize employs ongoing vulnerability scans to ensure the software is running optimally and free from defect.
